

National Board Roles and Responsibilities

COMMUNITY DIRECTOR

Main aspects to role:

- Organise ACE programme and promote to local chambers and members.
- Co-ordinate national community projects, such as Pound a Day, amnesty collections, Nothing But Nets etc that include chambers from across the UK.
- Act as the UK Peace is Possible manager.
- Act as the Point of contact for the 'Let's Do It World'
- Mentor local community directors.
- Support and promote local chambers' community projects.
- Promote JCI Active Citizens Day in December.

Time commitment outside of National Board meetings:

- Flexible in terms of timing of projects, although some projects such as Pound a Day have similar times each year.
- Visiting local chambers to support their events/projects at the invite of the chambers and discretion of the Community Director.

Key skills:

- Project co-ordination.
- Marketing/promotion.
- Motivation and inspiration of volunteers to support a cause.
- Liaison with partners.
